Violinist and violist **Martine denBok** holds a Bachelor of Music in violin performance from the University of Alberta and a Master of Music in violin performance from the University of Victoria. While studying in Victoria, she was a student of Ann Elliott-Goldschmid and the Lafayette String Quartet, worked as a student mentor, assisting public school string teachers and participated in workshops with Mimi Zweig, Gary Karr and Gwen Thompson.

Clarinetist **Nicola Everton**'s studies included a scholarship year at Arizona State University, and then four years the prestigious Curtis Institute of Music, and a winter at the Banff School of Fine Arts. As a musician in the Vancouver area, Nicola was a member of the Vancouver Symphony Orchestra for twenty years, and toured Asia with the orchestra. She was also active with chamber music groups in the city and a faculty member of the Vancouver Academy of Music. She extended her teaching year into summer festivals in Idaho and at UBC. Nicola now makes her music in the beautiful Kootenays and pursues her other passions—running and outdoor sports.

Susan Gould originates in Calgary, Alberta and has been performing as a pianist since her debut with the Mount Royal College orchestra at the age of eleven. She holds a Bachelor of Music with Distinction in Piano Performance from the University of Victoria and attended two years at The Banff Centre for the Performing Arts with full scholarship. Sue extended her classical training into the field of jazz, and has travelled throughout BC and Alberta performing solo piano, concertos, chamber music, jazz combos and duo-piano concerts. She is presently the artistic director of the Young Voices Children's choir and performs regularly with the trio, Music Mosaic.
