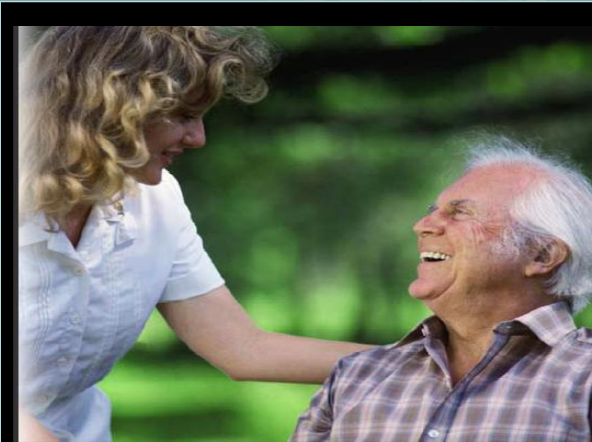

What do we do

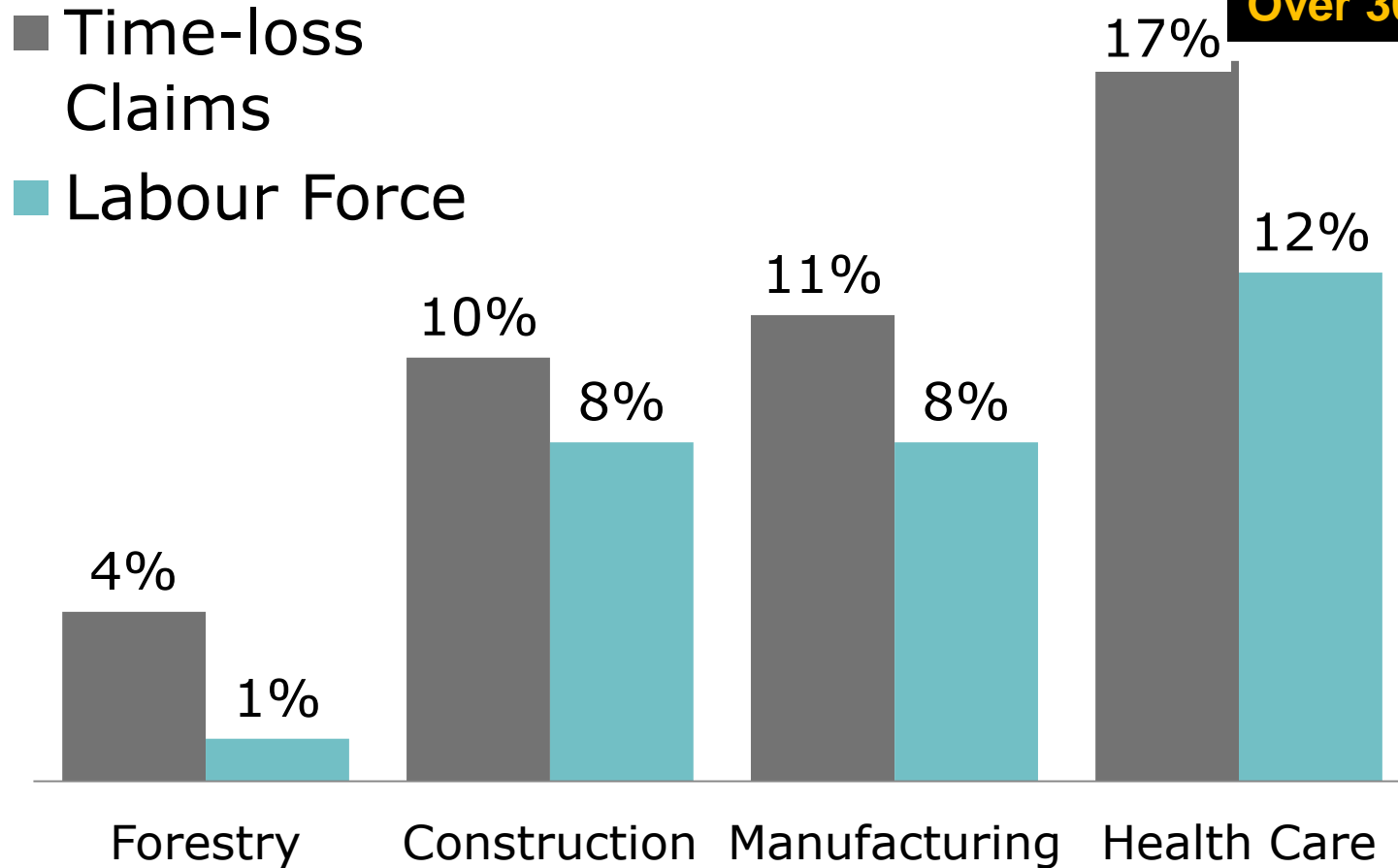
WorkSafeBC is made up of 3 primary functions:

BC's Top Industries

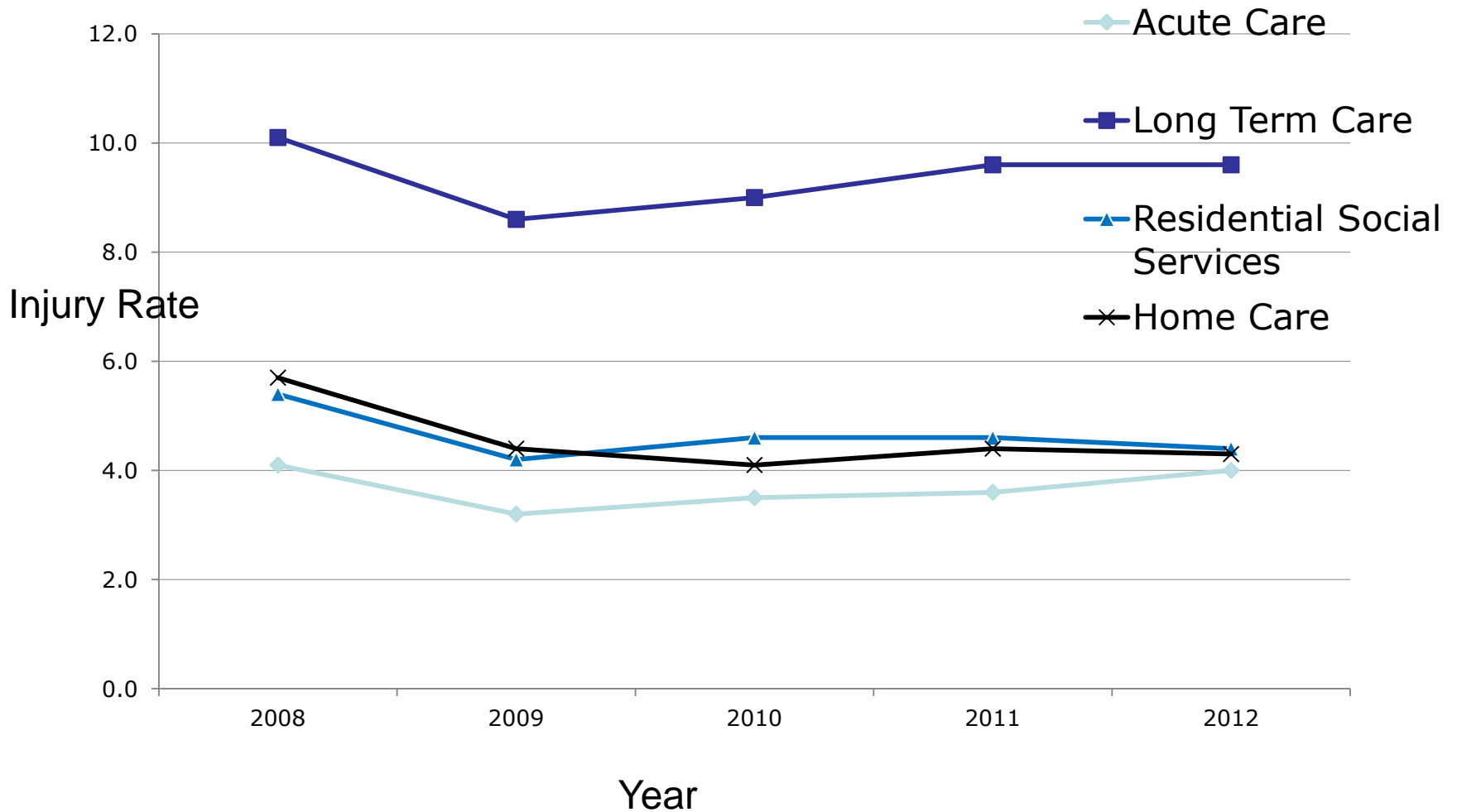

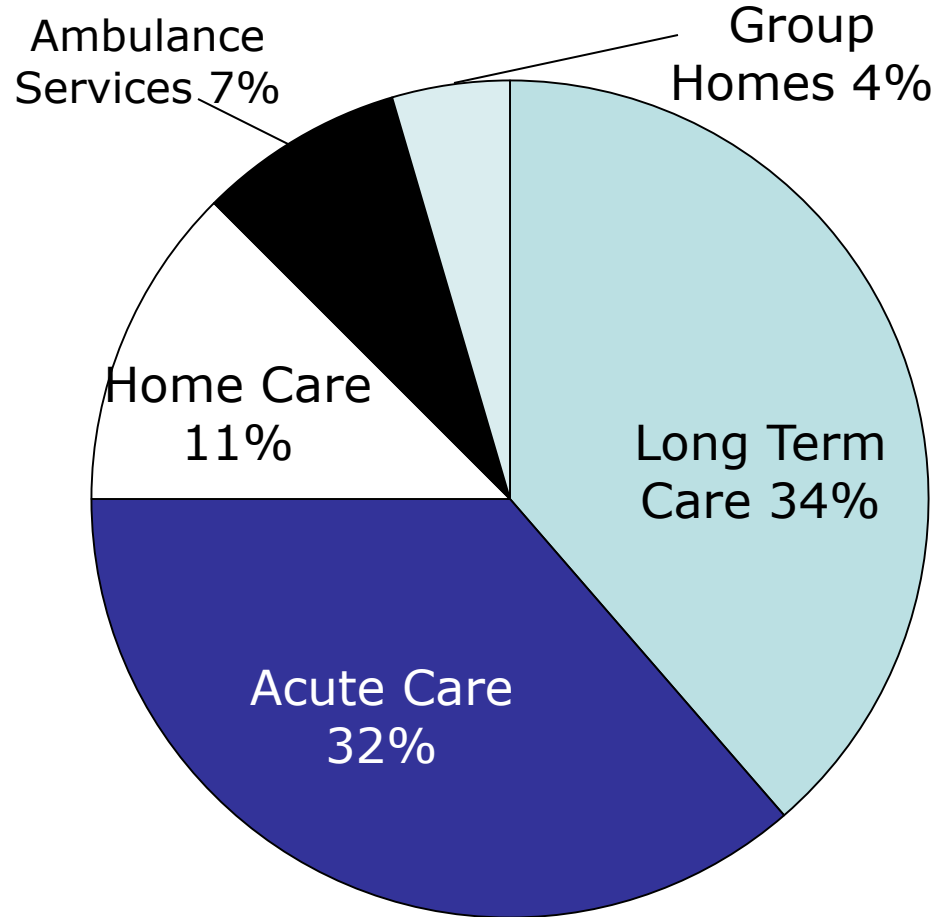



11% Acts of Violence

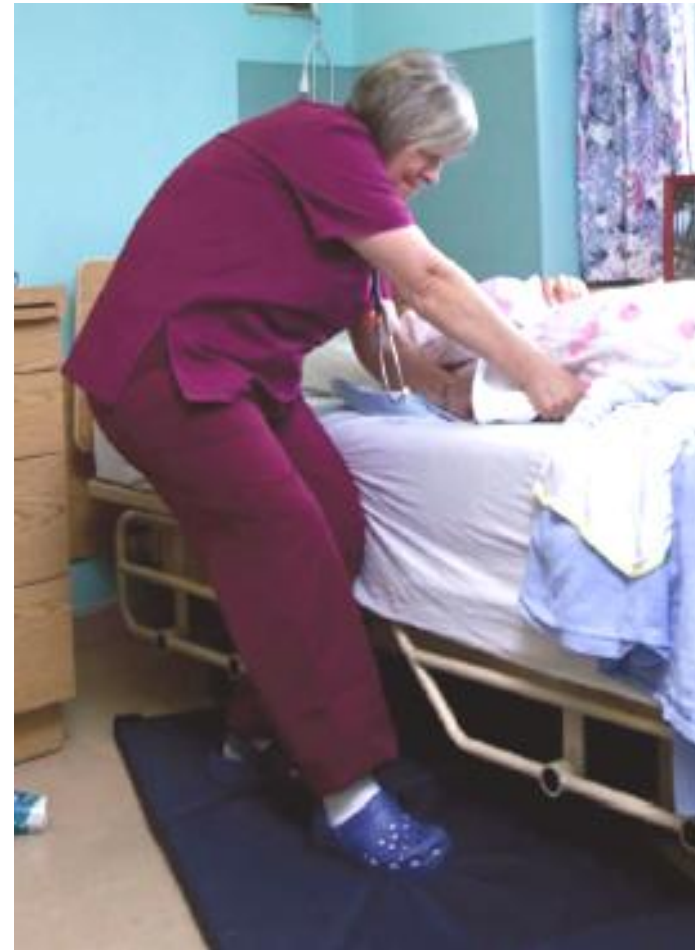
10% Struck by/against

Typical Injured Worker

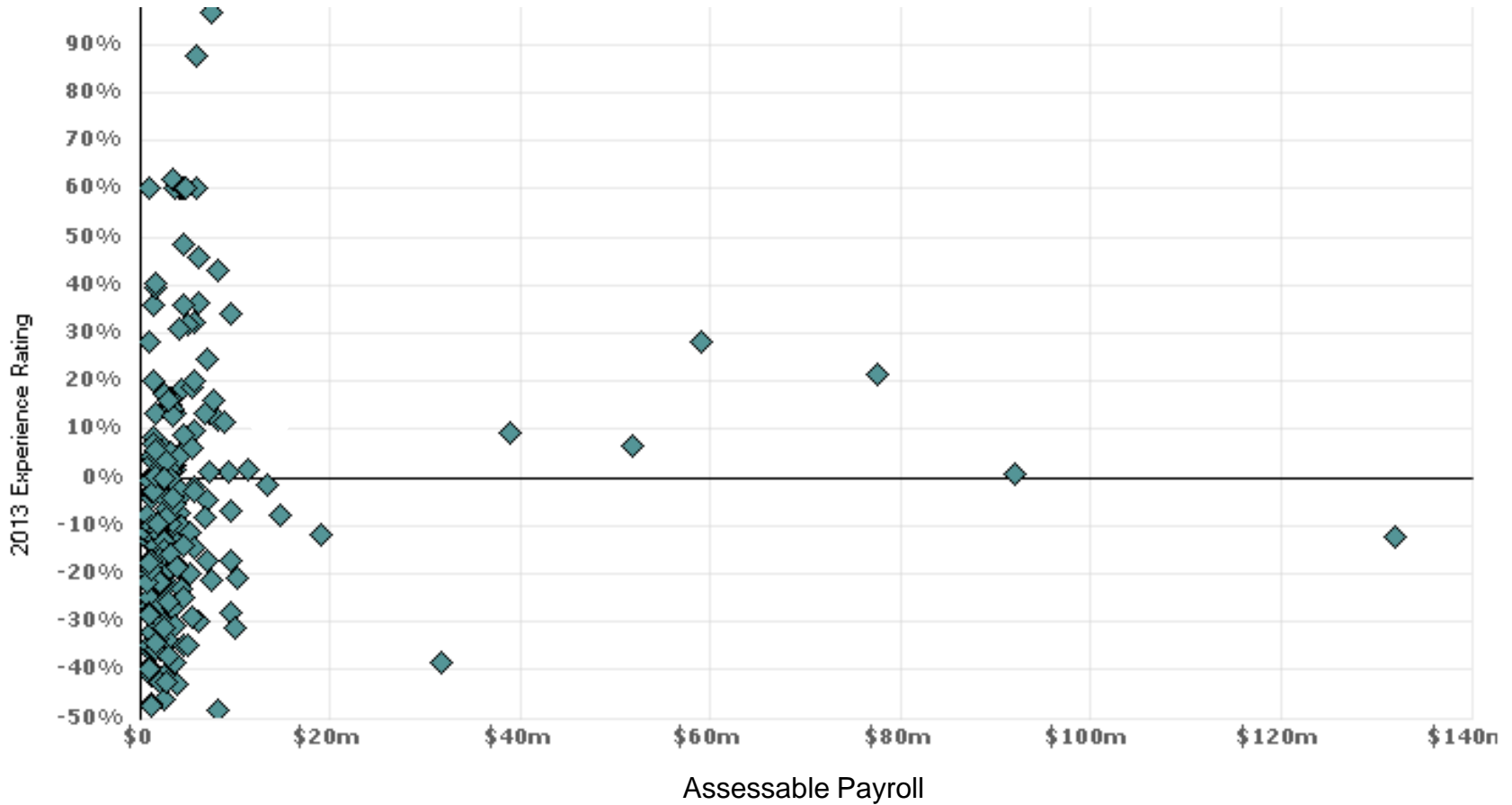
- Female

Comparative Scatter Plot

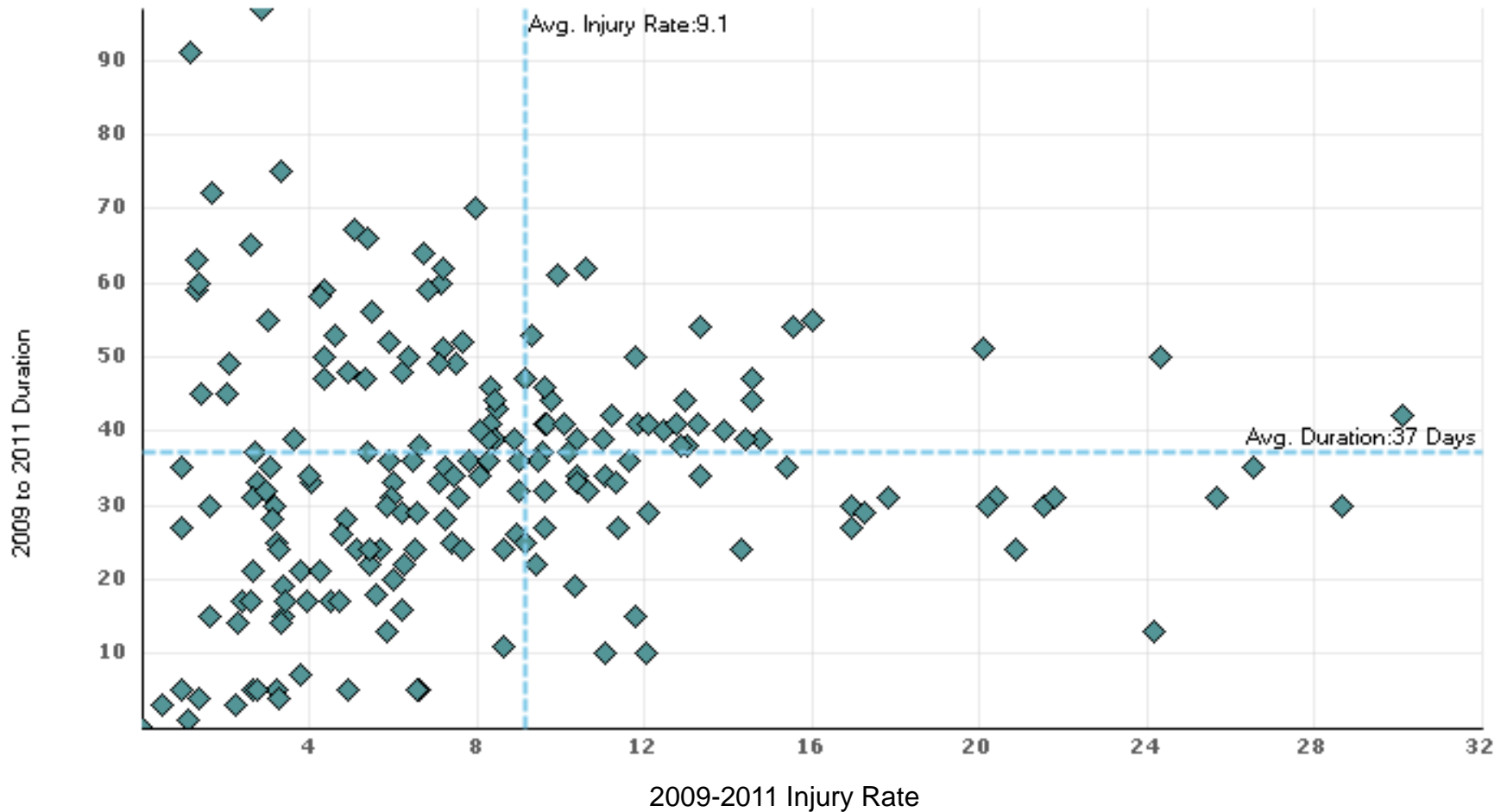
Experience Rate vs. Assessable Payroll

Long Term Care (766011) Large and Medium size employers



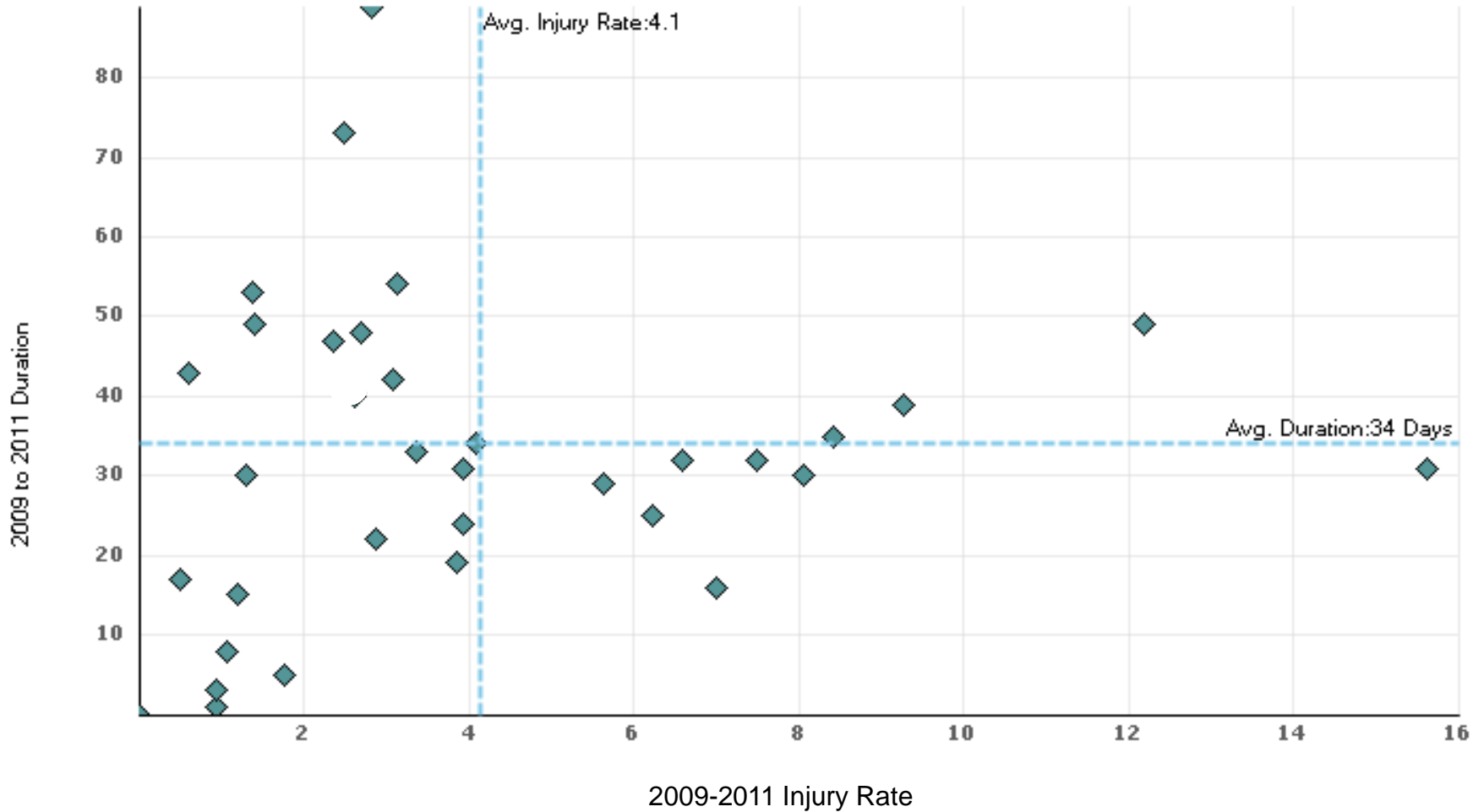
Comparative Scatter Plot Injury Rate and Duration

Patient Care/Safety vs. Worker Safety



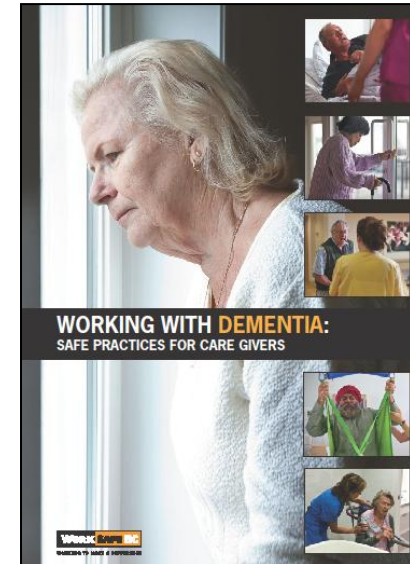
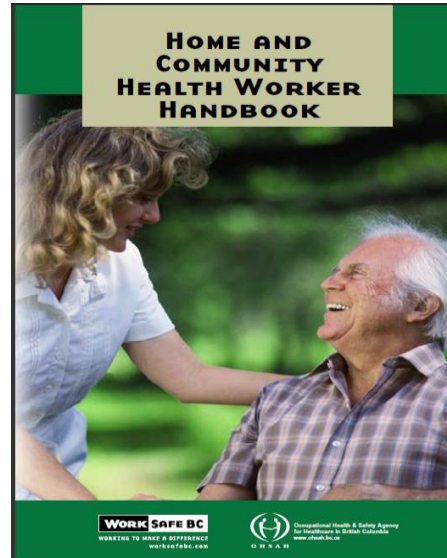
