Julie Begg is a graduate and Fellow of Trinity College of Music, London. She freelanced as a clarinettist and saxophonist in England for many years performing in symphony orchestras, chamber ensembles and West End musicals before emigrating to Canada. Now in Vancouver she has

established herself as a full-time instructor and maintains a large private studio. She also works independently as a clinician, providing educational workshops in secondary schools and at band retreats. Julie is the clarinettist with the Erato Ensemble, Wind Song and Primario Trios. She is also a director and music supervisor with Quantum Music Works, Inc., a boutique music licensing agency.



Pianist Karen Lee-Morlang has been a fixture on the Canadian musical scene for over the past 15 years. After obtaining a post-graduate degree from the University of British Columbia, she then taught as a Sessional Lecturer at the University for four years. Karen has produced recital and lecture series for the Vancouver Art Gallery, UBC Main Library, Vancouver Opera and the Vancouver Public Library. Karen has been thrilled to reach an even wider audience base by hosting programmes

for CBC Radio. She accompanies the Vancouver Welsh Men's Choir and is a founding member of the swingin' vocal quartet, The Lady Larks. In early 2017 she took on the newly-created role of Associate Artistic Director of Health Arts Society.
