

SSQIP: Basic Program Guidelines and Eligibility Criteria

Your care home must meet all the following eligibility criteria to apply for SSQIP funding*:

- Long-term senior residential care home in BC
- · Publicly funded senior residents
- Non-government owned-operated

How Much Can Our Care Home Apply for?

In phase one of the program, up to \$500 per funded senior resident by eligible long-term residential care home provider is available. Long-term senior residential care home providers can apply once and carry forward any unused amounts into another funding period to cover short or long-term expected needs.

*Initial \$10 Million Grant

When Should I Apply?

The allocation of up to \$500 per funded senior resident, per residential care home is secured to September 30th, 2019. You can apply when you have identified and cost out your needs. This funding is allotted to you and there will be at least three opportunities in a year to apply in the open application periods. The first application period will open on January 15th, 2018 and close February 29th. All submitted applications completed by the deadline will be reviewed in March 2018.

<u>Begins</u>: When the Terms & Conditions are accepted, and the complete application is received prior to the closing date of the funding period.

Ends: When the applicant receives a decision on grant funding.
