ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS the role of seniors care providers has become even more important with a growing complexity of care needs, an aging population and a move to more community-based care, and

WHEREAS recognition and appreciation is extended to seniors care providers for their dedication and commitment to improving the quality of life for the individuals they care for, while balancing their own work and family obligations, and

WHEREAS seniors care providers deliver a vast continuum of services with compassion, professionalism and generosity on a daily basis, and

WHEREAS seniors care providers are helping to build healthy, age-friendly communities and assisting many British Columbians to overcome challenges that they face in their later years;

NOW KNOW YE THAT, We do by these presents proclaim and declare that February 19, 2018 shall be known as

“BC Seniors Care Providers Day”

in the Province of British Columbia.
