

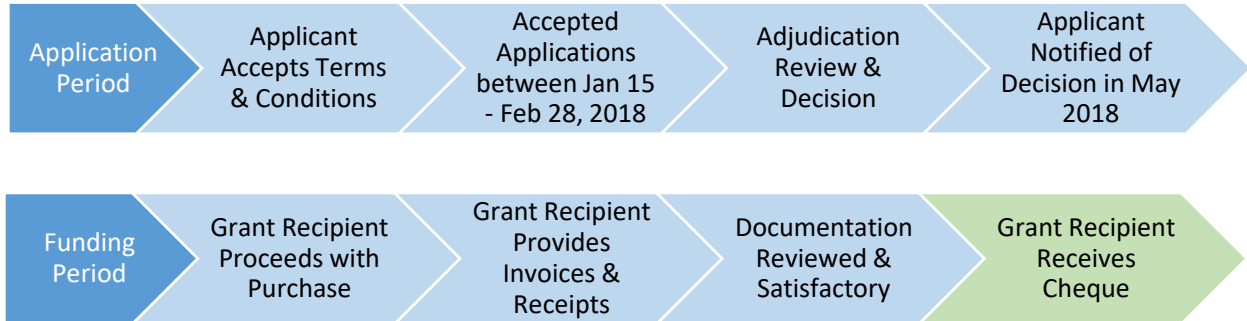

Overview



SSQIP Summary: Period 1 2018

Application Rate

The first open application period of 2018 received 88 submissions with an application rate of approximately 47% of eligible care homes.

Senior Safety & Quality of Life (QoL)

Of each item requested for funding, applicants identified that these items will have a positive outcome to improve senior safety and/or QoL. Majority of items requested also had additional benefits to improve employee safety.

90% of Requests Will Improve **Both Senior Safety & QoL**

Figure 1. Funding Requests by Category

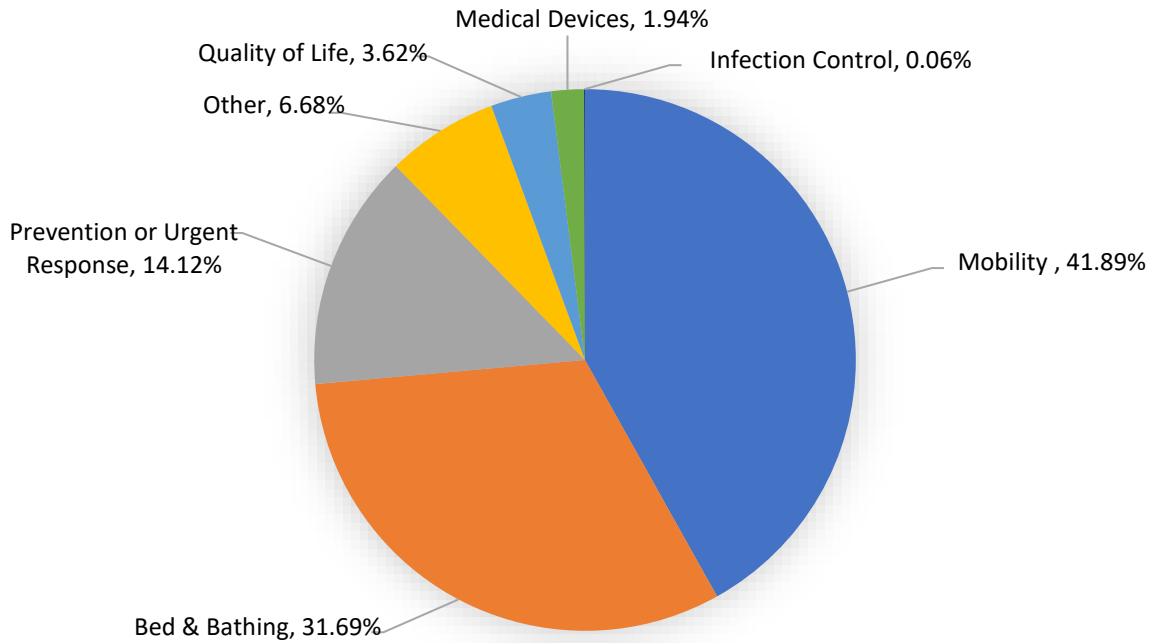

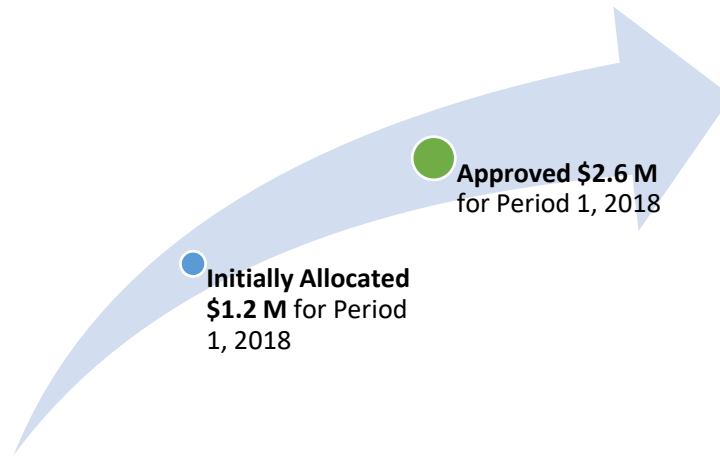

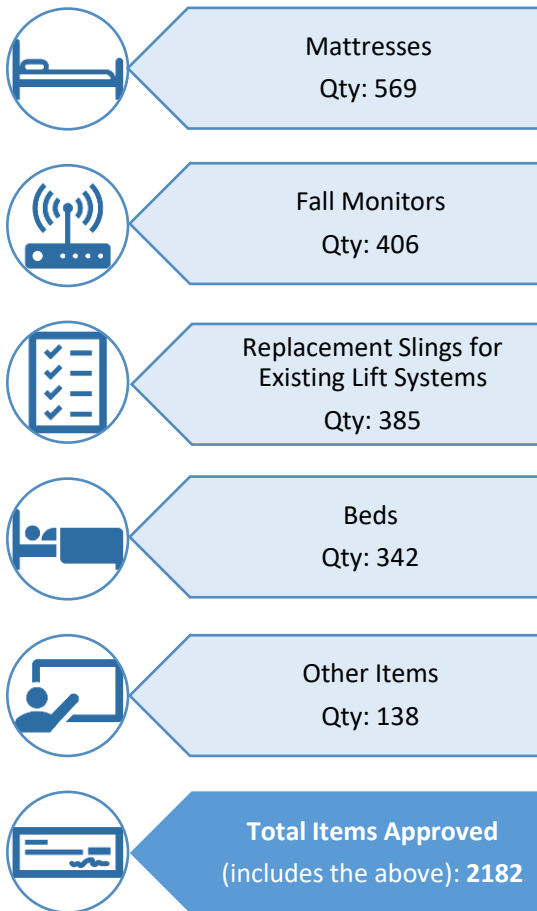
Approved Funding

Initially the BCCPA allocated up to \$1.2 million of funding for the first period, however due to the strength and number of submissions, \$2.6 million of funding has been approved.
