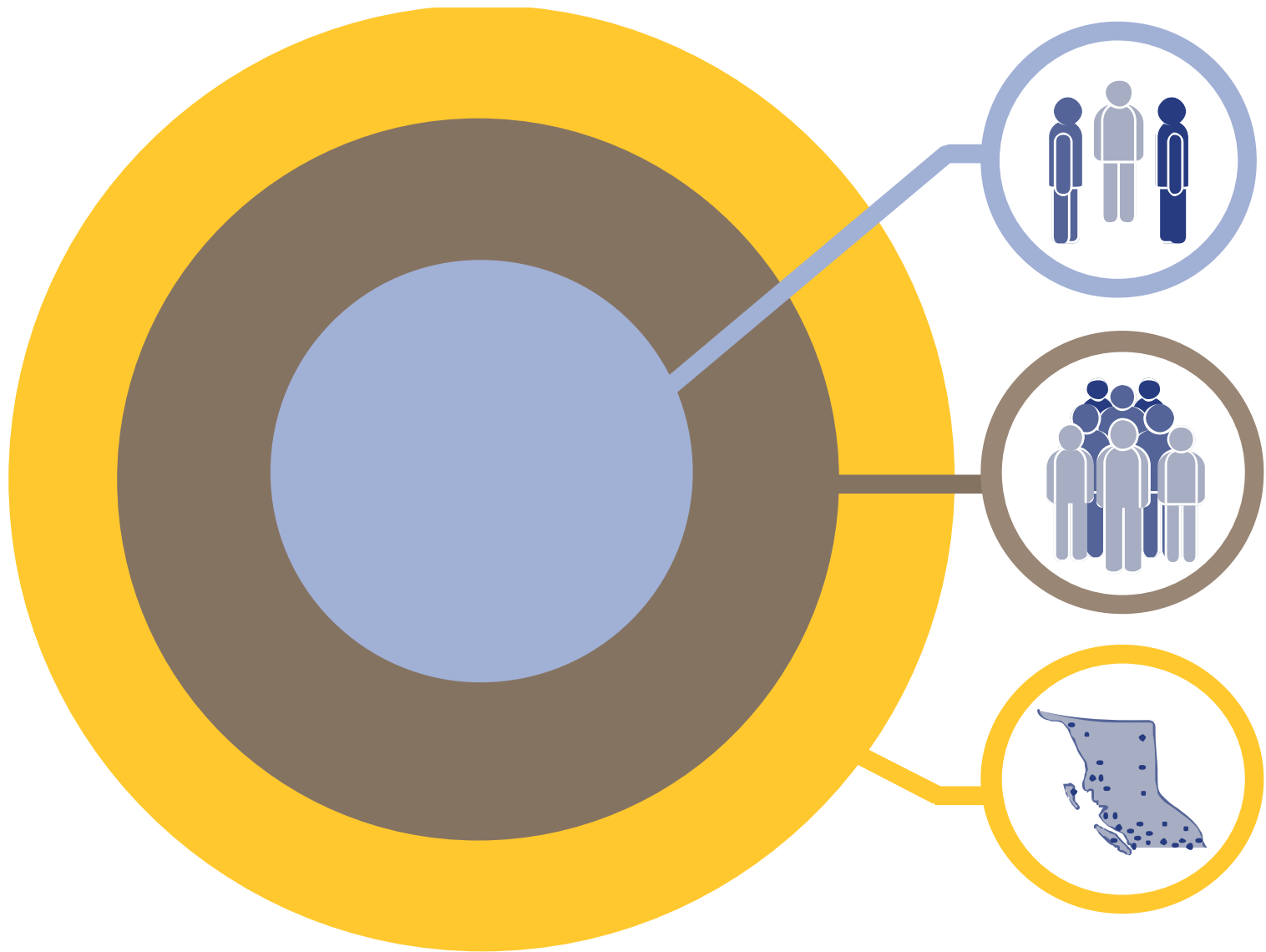


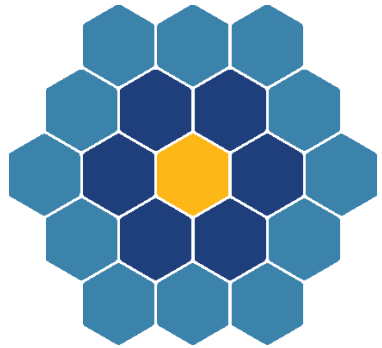

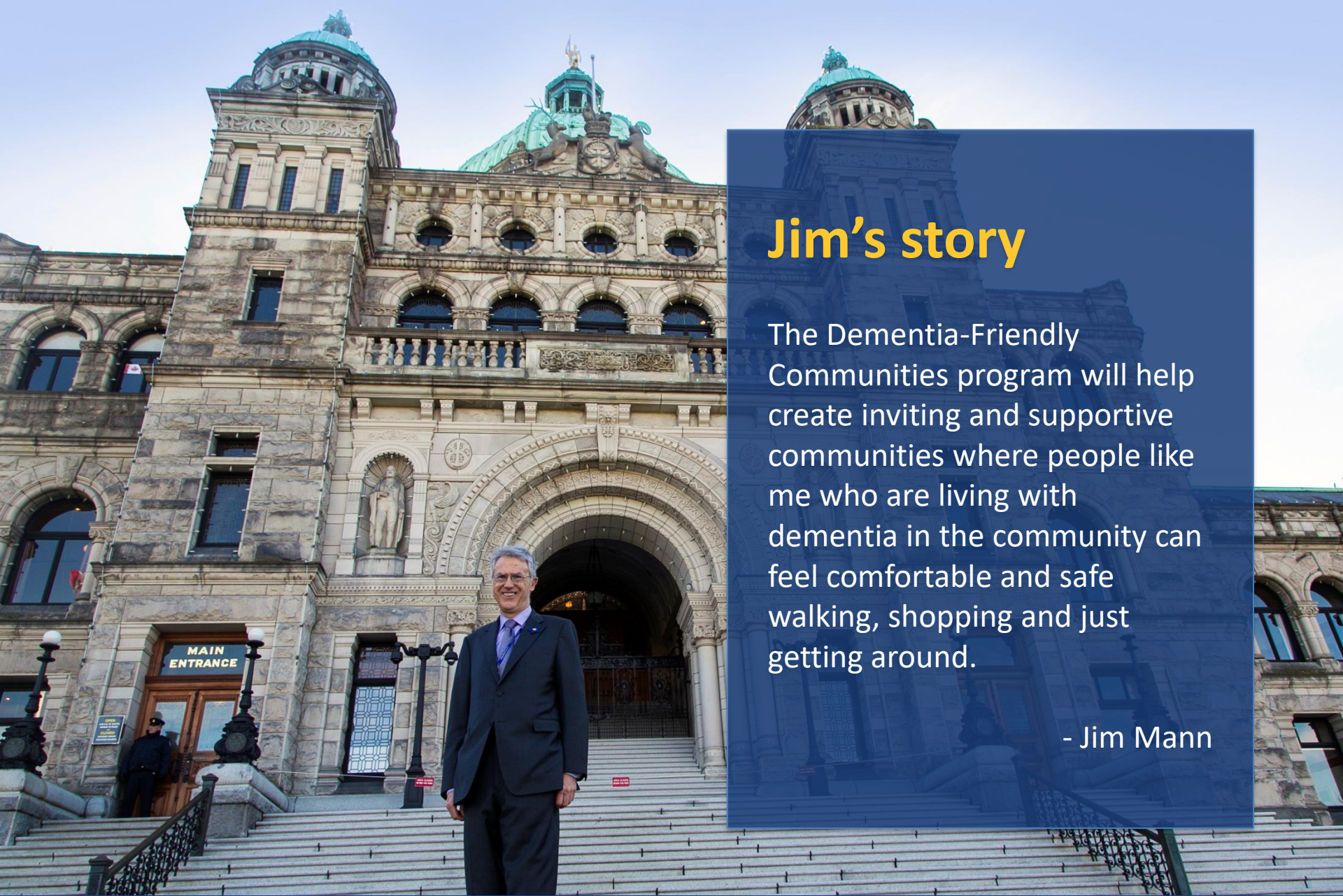
Community
