## Ability411

- Ability411 allows seniors and their caregivers the opportunity to ask questions and get answers about assistive technology
- The website was designed to fill a gap in knowledge about the assistive technologies available to seniors
- Questions are reviewed by the Canadian Association of Occupational Therapists – BC





## How Ability411 Works

- Users can browse previously asked questions answered by Ability411, or they can submit their own questions.
- Categories include communication and computers, dressing, personal hygiene, eating and meal preparation, mobility aids and walking aids.

### What are you having difficulty with?

Type a question you'd like to ask an Ability411 team member. \*

E.g. Are there any apps or electronic gadgets that I can use to create a memory box for a family member who has recently been diagnosed with dementia?

## Example cases

- Pamela has difficulty navigating the tiny buttons of her blouses and shirts due to her arthritis. She didn't think anything existed that could fix this relatively simple problem.
- \$16 button aid hook from Amazon and other retailers.
