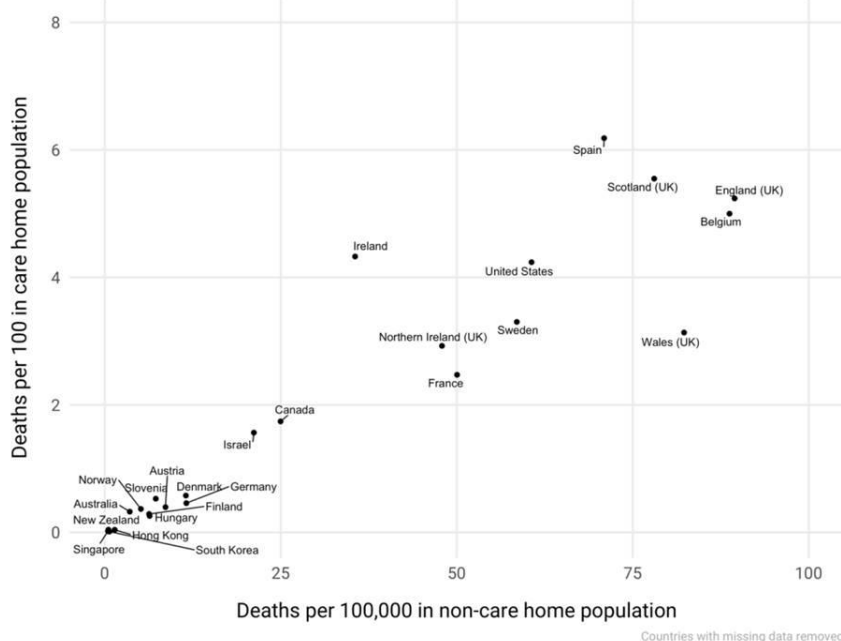


Figure 1: Comparison of COVID-19 related deaths per 100 care home population with COVID-19 related deaths per 100,000 community-based (non-care home) population

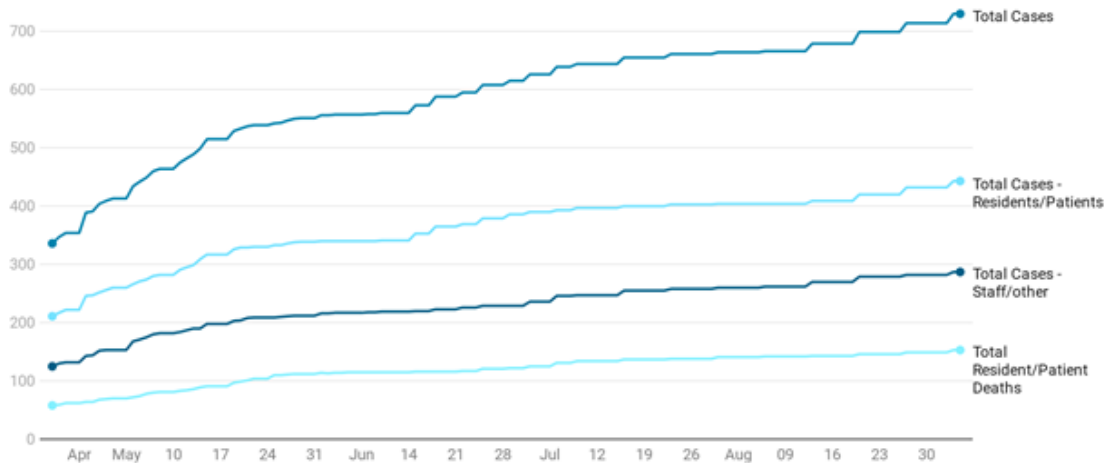

**Seniors' Care Residences in BC continue to experience COVID-19 positive cases**

There are currently 730 cases in long-term care, assisted living and acute care settings in British Columbia. That includes 443 resident/patient cases and 287 staff cases. Sadly, 153 residents have passed away from COVID-19.

**Seniors Care Residences under Outbreak Protocols increases with community spread**

The number of care homes under outbreak protocols due to cases of COVID-19 has increased in the past several weeks, as community spread has increased in the province. An outbreak is declared when there is at least one confirmed case of COVID-19 among staff and/or residents. There are currently 10 active outbreaks and 41 outbreaks have been declared over.
