PERCEPTION OF IL


Just over three-in-four respondents have a positive opinion of independent living homes.

Amongst the respondents aged 45-to-64, 32% envision their older friend or relative moving into an independent living home/retirement community in the next 10 years+.




47% of those 64+ could envision moving into an independent living home within the next ten years.




Four-in-five respondents say a quality assurance program would make them "very likely" or "moderately likely" to choose a retirement community or home health organization.
