We meet regularly with Ministry of Health officials, MLAs and MPs from all parties, in addition to health authority representatives. We also submit a budget submission to the Minister of Finance on behalf of our members each year.

# HEALTH HUMAN RESOURCES

#### SUPPORTING A DIVERSE WORKFORCE

A major area of BCCPA's advocacy efforts have focused on supporting and strengthening B.C.'s continuing care workforce. We lead various initiatives such as including managing public funding for vocational training, working with industry leaders such as SafeCare BC, and ensuring B.C.'s HHR crisis is on the agenda of key political decision-makers.

SafeCare BC is an industry funded, non-profit health and safety association established in 2013 through the support of BCCPA and other stakeholders. Offering evidence-based education, advocacy for safer workplaces, leadership and collaboration, SafeCare BC strives to support injury-free, safe working conditions for continuing care workers in B.C. and be the industry leader in empowering those connected to B.C.'s continuing care sector to create a culture of safety.

BCCPA's policy team publishes quality research, and has produced influential reports driving sector innovation and tackling the key issues facing B.C.'s seniors' living and care operators.







BCCPA offers a suite of diverse program offerings designed to support the leading priorities and interests of B.C.'s seniors' living and care sector.

From vocational training programs, administering funding for seniors' safety and quality of life, marketing initiatives, and enhancing public awareness on seniors' living and wellness options, our programs reflect the areas that matter most to B.C.'s seniors' living and care operators.

#### **HCA TRAINING PROGRAM**

With funding provided by the Ministry of Advanced Education & Skills Training, BCCPA partners with B.C.'s leading educational providers to provide free training by way of the provincially approved curriculum for HCAs. Hundreds have already graduated from our **HCA Training Program** and started their new health care careers, many becoming employed at BCCPA member organizations.



#### TRA TRAINING PROGRAM

The **TRA Training Program** is BCCPA's newest vocational training program, providing fully funded training by way of an industry recognized curriculum for TRAs. Launched in spring 2022, the opportunity is made possible with funding from the Ministry of Advanced Education & Skills Training.





#### **ENERGY SAVINGS PROGRAM**

Our **Energy Savings Program** helps find ways to lower energy costs through targeted retrofits of mechanical and electrical systems. We can analyze your historical building consumption data, complete a walk-through energy audit, and come up with a plan to help achieve your savings goals. We also maximize all utility and government incentives to help reduce up-front capital costs.

Members receive a free listing on **Route65.ca**, an online platform that connects the public with services offered by B.C.'s leading operators of independent living, assisted living, long-term care and home health care. Website visitors are guided by Walter, Route65.ca's virtual concierge, or they can call Route65.ca's toll-free call centre and speak to Wendy for assistance navigating options.


