- A culture or belief system in which safety has become a sacred value, which means that people become unwilling to make trade-offs demanded by other practical and moral concerns.

What Can We Do?

1. Involve people in their own care decisions
2. Ask about life history before making any care decisions
 - a. “When did you feel most alive?”
 - b. “What are your biggest fear and worries about the future with your health?”
3. Address safety concerns non-confrontationally with real data to allow people to make decisions directly
