- Baccalaureate degree in nursing or equivalent education and experience required. Preference will be given to those holding or pursuing a Master's degree.
- Completion of a gerontology certificate program an asset.
- Minimum of five (5) years administrative/supervisory experience in the field of geriatrics or long-term care.
- Must be in good health. Job requires long periods of standing and walking, and long periods of concentration.
- Must demonstrate the ability to communicate effectively, organize, supervise and evaluate the delivery of health care.

• Must be able to promote positive working relationships both within the nursing department and with other departments, and with community contacts.
