- Ensure workforce competence by establishing educational /credential requirements for practice

- Protect vulnerable clients
- Establish and improve standards of care
- Promote professional development and assist in identifying career opportunities

- ‘Risk Registry:’ Repository of individuals found to have abused or neglected vulnerable adults

- Connect Continuing Care Assistants (CCAs) for purpose of disseminating info and receiving input on occupational/systemic issues
- Repository of CCA demographics
- Provide contact information to employers

- Recognize Personal Support Workers (PSWs) as an important part of the health care system
- Increase access of public to PSWs to meet employment needs
- Support enhanced public safety
- Increase Health Human Resource (HHR) planning capacity by making data publicly available
