Scope of Request

The purpose of this Request for Proposal (RFP) is to select a contractor to conduct analysis and provide recommendations regarding the BCCPA's membership fee structure and composition.

- Conduct a thorough review of our current membership structure and composition. This
 would include analysis of whether BCCPA is in line with other similar continuing care
 sector organizations throughout Canada and/or industry associations with a similar
 membership base/composition.
- Conduct analysis with our Board of Directors and members and include commentary/recommendations regarding whether the current composition of the BCCPA membership (85% residential care + 15% home care) supports our efforts to remain an effective and unified voice for the majority of our membership.
- Conduct online & telephone satisfaction surveys of our members regarding the current suite of programs and services offered by the BCCPA.
- Assess what types of services/programs members would like the BCCPA to develop and deliver which would help further increase our value proposition.
- Provide recommendations for a new and/or updated member fee structure that could be implemented effective January 1, 2017. A new fee structure should ideally meet the following principles:
 - Equitable between smaller and larger care home operators
 - o Equitable between residential care, assisted living and home care providers
 - Affordable to single site members under 150 care beds
 - Easy to administer & understand
 - Directly supports the delivery of our Strategic Plan and overall corporate goals and objectives
- Provide recommendations regarding how to increase value proposition of membership to care homes currently not affiliated with the BCCPA.

Confidentiality

Proposals will be kept confidential and the successful bid will be assessed and verified by CEO Daniel Fontaine. The successful proponent will be notified by no later than **Friday**, **July 24th**, **2015**.

Right to Cancel

The BC Care Providers Association has the right to cancel at any time this RFP or any part of any agreement resulting from it.

Governing Law

This Request for Proposal and any proposal submitted in response to it will be governed by the laws of the Province of British Columbia. Any dispute arising out of this RFP or its process will first be mediated. If mediation is unsuccessful, the dispute will be determined by a court of competent jurisdiction in the Province of British Columbia.

BCCPA Rights

The BC Care Providers Association reserves the right to:

- reject any or all proposals;
- re-issue this RFP;
- cancel this RFP with or without issuing another RFP;
- supplement, amend, substitute or otherwise modify this RFP;
- permit or reject modifications to or corrections of proposals; and
- request additional or clarifying information or more detailed information from any proponent.

Decisions

By responding to this RFP, proponents will be deemed to have agreed that the decision of the BC Care Providers Association is final and binding.
